News from Floyd

An amendment by Nevada's other senator John Ensign (R) to the D.C. Voting Rights Act(S160) would repeal all the junk laws the city administration has conjured up to avoid the Heller decision that returned the right to arms to the citizens of that city. Both Oregon Senators voted against the bill. The bill has since been pulled by the Democrats because it seems they are afraid of passing any bill that would be pro-gun rights for D.C. residents.

Last year an Oregon appellate court ruled, in a case involving concealed carry, that the interior of a person's private automobile is a "public place" for the purpose of enforcing a loaded firearm ordinance. A bill (SB569) in the legislature would clarify that the interior of a person's vehicle is not a public place.

A.G. Holder stated at a news conference that the "assault Weapons" ban should be reinstated due to the violence on the Mexican side of the border blaming the U.S. for the illegal weapons supposedly obtained here. A faction of 65 democrats has sent a letter to A.G. Holder opposing the move. The majority Leader, Harry Reid stated he would oppose any move to reinstate the ban. Pelosi said "we should enforce existing laws first".

SB 852 will abolish the OSP background check system and process future requests through the NICS (FBI).

SB953 would impose a 14 day waiting period on all gun purchases through a licensed dealer.

SB 954 would require any firearm lost or stolen to be reported within 48 hours.

Obama has pulled funding for the armed airline pilots program so no more pilots can be certified to carry a firearm. The money that was diverted is now utilized in a "supervisory" program for pilots, or in other words a harassment program.
